Bishop Kurt has asked for our participation in the U. S.
 Conference of Catholic Bishops' (USCCB) special
 collection to provide humanitarian relief and pastoral
 support for our affected brothers and sisters in the
 Middle East. **The collection will be held during the
 weekend of September 13-14.**

This special appeal is a great concern for the ongoing crisis in the Middle East. The Church mourns the
 terrible suffering of Christians and other innocent victims of violence in Iraq and Syria who are struggling
 to survive, protect their children and live with dignity in dire conditions.

Money given to the collection will be disbursed for humanitarian needs by Catholic Relief Services (CRS)
 and other Catholic agencies working in partnership with the local Church.

"Our Christian brothers and sisters and other innocent victims of the violence in the Middle East urgently
 need the assistance of the Catholic community of the United States," wrote Archbishop Kurtz, President
